# **Cookies Policy**

### What is a cookie?

A cookie is a piece of information saved on your personal computer at the time of browsing a website which you have visited. Cookies enable easier use since they save your settings for websites (language or address) and they are reactivated upon revisiting the site again. In this way, the information is tailored to your needs and regular methods of use.

From the simple information about the settings, cookies can also save a large amount of information (name, e-mail address) which you must give complete access to. If you do not enable them, the cookies cannot access information on your computer. The activities of saving and sending by cookies is not visible to you, however in the settings of your web browser you can choose to approve/disapprove the requirements for storing cookies, deleting saved cookies and other activities connected with the use of cookies.

#### How to enable cookies

By turning off cookies you do not allow them to be stored on your computer. Cookie settings can be configured and changed with the chosen Internet browser. If you disable cookies, you will not be able to use certain functionalities of websites.

## What are temporary cookies?

Temporary cookies, or session cookies, remove themselves from your personal computer at the moment of closing the Internet browser with which you have viewed a website. With the help of these cookies, sites store temporary information.

## What are permanent cookies?

Permanent, or stored, cookies remain in your personal computer even after closing the Internet browser. With the help of these cookies websites store information in order to simplify your use. For example, websites that require the input of a username and password will "remember" your input which will appear upon every new visit. Permanent cookies will remain recorded in your computer for days, months or years.

## What are first-party cookies?

First-party cookies come from websites which you are viewing, and can be temporary or permanent. In this way, websites store information which will make use easier upon every new visit to that website.

## What are third-party cookies?

Third-party cookies on your computer come from other web places which are located on websites which you are viewing, for example, pop-up ads. Here cookies have the role of following websites for advertising purposes.

### Does this website use cookies?

Yes, this website uses cookies in order to ensure you a simpler and more useful experience.

### What kind of cookies does this website use?

- Temporary cookies (session cookies) these cookies will automatically be deleted once you close the Internet browser with which you are working
- Permanent cookies (persistent cookies) these are cookies which will remain "recorded" in your Internet browser until they expire or you remove them yourself manually. The collected information is anonymous, and does not include your private data

# Does it have third-party cookies?

There do exist several external services which store your limited cookies, but this website has not placed them. Limited cookies are used for the free use of features which allow users easier access to content. This website enables:
